- 7 The Judges, Stewards, Committees decision is final
- 8 Produce and Cookery entries no later than 10:30am for judging at 11am
- 9 No entry to leave the field before 2:00pm

- 11 Any objection or protest must be handed into the Secretary's Tent in writing and signed within half an hour of the event, together with a deposit of £5.00 which will be forfeited should the Committee decide the objection is not substantiated
